Reference letter for ECPHM Diplomate Re-cetification



GENERAL GUIDANCE

According to the valid version of our Constitution and Bylaws, the Diplomate re-certification shall be supported by two (2) letters of reference from other Diplomates.

Who is eligible to support re-certification of a Diplomate as a referee?

A referee must know the applicant to such level that one can confirm the below mentioned criteria.

Preferrably a referee should be a Diplomate of the ECPHM from the same country. Alternatively a Diplomate of the ECPHM from another country, another EBVS-recognised Diplomate from the same country or a senior acedemic colleague (e.g. Head of Department, Dean) may act as a referee. Only one academic colleague at the same institute may provide a letter of reference. It is not allowed that the referee is a relative or partner (business or social) of the applicant. Persons connected in a direct reporting line within an institute or company cannot function as a referee for each other.

How long does a referee need to know the applicant?

A referee must have known the applicant for the five-year period prior to application for re-certification. A professional and not a personal reference is required.

How to fill-out this template?

Page 2:

- You may insert a logo from your computer by clicking on the icon in the upper left corner
- Add your full name & contact details on the upper right corner (you may slightly edit the text within the file OR copy & paste any formated text)
- Add the applicants name
- Check boxes as appropriate

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- You may add any other comments if desired
- Add your name & the date
- Add your electronic signature (alternatively: print, sign and scan the document)
 - o Please follow instruction after clicking on the respective box
 - Activate the checkbox for locking the document after signing (no changes possible after saving)
 - o In any case do not edit the document after signing or repeat the signing process, as the system will alert on any changes on the document done post signing
